Gernot Becker joined the R&D department of the e-mobility Team at RWE in 2010.

After studying physics at the University of Dortmund he works as a scientific employee at the University of Münster. In 1998 he published his PhD thesis in the field of surface and condensed matter physics. The main key topics at this time were to develop new kind of surface microscopes for semiconductor analysis.

In the beginning of 1998 Gernot Becker started to work at Siemens Semiconductor – which was renamed to Infineon Semiconductor later. At this time he was focused on the failure analysis and production coordination of semiconductor circuits.

Gernot Becker moved over to Dortmund to work for ELMOS Semiconductor in 2001. His role at ELMOS Semiconductor was to lead the technology development for automotive semiconductor. Since 2007 he was responsible for the whole R&D activities of ELMOS Semiconductor.
